In this Book is this Note — Concerning this Epistola
Lugubris of Rodericus Santius, see Fabr. Bibl. Medicæ
& Infirme Lainitatis, pag. 113 and 114. Edit. Venet.
Vol. 6.—Fabricius knows nothing of this being printed,
but gives you an Account of a MS. of it in the Va-
tican under this title *Relatio de Negropontis Expugna-
tione*, and refers you to page 141 of Montfaucon's
Bibliotheca Bibliothecarum. — It was certainly printed
before the Death of Santius who died in the year 1470
— He published in his Life time at Rome *Speculum Vitæ
humane, &c.* which Swaynheim and Pannartz printed in
the year 1468, and his *Historia Hispana* in 1470—Pro-
bably this Epistle was sent to Schoefffer at Mentz between
1466 and 67 to be printed, as then they had no printing
House in Italy — It is the very same Type with the
Valerius Maximus of Mentz, 1471, and probably the first
Essay of that Type, as it has neither Printers Name,
Place or Date.
