In this Book is this Note — Concerning this *Epistola Lugubris* of Rodericus Santius, see *Fabr. Bibl. Medicæ & Infimæ Latinitatis*, pag. 113 and 114. *Edit. Venet. Vol. 6.* — *Fabricius* knows nothing of this being printed, but gives you an Account of a MS. of it in the Vatican under this title *Relatio de Negropontis Expugnatione*, and refers you to page 141 of *Montfaucon's Bibliotheca Bibliothecarum.* — It was certainly printed before the Death of *Santius* who died in the year 1470 — He published in his Life time at Rome *Speculum Vitæ humanæ, &c.* which *Sweynheim* and *Pannartz* printed in the year 1468, and his *Historia Hispana* in 1470 — Probably this Epistle was sent to *Schoeffer* at *Mentz* between 1466 and 67 to be printed, as then they had no printing House in Italy — It is the very same Type with the *Valerius Maximus* of *Mentz*, 1471, and probably the first Essay of that Type, as it has neither Printers Name, Place or Date.
