RICHARD HAKLUYT.

The principal Nauigations, Voiages, Traffiques and Discouries of the English Nation, made by Sea or ouer-land, to the remote and farthest distant quarters of the Earth, at any time within the compasse of these 1500. yeeres: Deuided into three seuerall Volumes: according to the positions of the Regions, whereunto they were directed. This first Volume containing the woorthy Discouries, &c. of the English toward the North and Northeast by sea, as of *Lapland, Scritfinia, Corelia*, the Baie of S. *Nicolas*, the Isles of *Colgoieu, Vaigatz, and Noua Zembla*, toward the great riuer *Ob*, with the mighty Empire of *Russia*, the *Caspian sea, Georgia, Armenia, Media, Perſia, Bogbar in Bac̄tria*, and diuers Kingdoms of *Tartaria*: Together with many notable monuments and testimonies of the ancient forren trades, and of the warlike and other ſhipping of this realme of England in former ages. Whereunto is annexed alſa a briefe Commentarie of the true ſtate of Island, and of the Northen Seas and lands ſituate that way. And laſtly, the memorable defeate of the Spanish huge Armada, Anno 1588. and the famous victorie atchieued at the citie of *Cadiz*, 1596. are described.
